Professional Experience and key achievements

Governance

- Following a year as a non-executive director at UC24, a social enterprise providing urgent care in Merseyside, I took over as Chair of the organization in September 2012. In this role I am responsible for ensuring good governance and excellent services for patients.
- Between 2009 2011 I was Independent Chair of Community Services Bury, an NHS community health care provider, with a value of £30 million. In line with national policy, I led the options appraisal and subsequent merger of the organisation with a successful foundation trust.
- At Salford Primary Care Trust in 2005, I negotiated the governance arrangements whereby powers were ceded to community groups to allow them to run heath services. This resulted in the establishment of the Angel Centre.

Organisational and cultural Change

- In 2008 I was commissioned by NHS Walsall to establish a cultural change programme, as a means of improving the delivery of public services to children and young people. This resulted in the direct training of all community based team leaders, and cascade training to all staff in the area of enhanced client communication and direct feedback.
- In 2006 I was approached by Bury Primary Care Trust to undertake an initial organizational diagnostic, which led to leading a 2 year turnaround project, management restructure, sustained cost-improvements and improvement in reputation.
- As part of Greater Manchester's "Making it Better" Programme to reprovide maternity and children's services, I led Salford's public consultation, which resulted in a definitive outcome.

People orientated Service Redesign

- As part of the Prime Ministers Intervention on Health Visiting, I led the introduction of text messaging as a means of generating direct service user feedback. In May 2012 the project was independently evaluated by Price Waterhouse Cooper and promoted as excellent practice.
- As Director of Development at Salford PCT between 2002 and 2006 I was responsible for capital planning and service redesign, I led on the establishment of the local LIFT company and went on to oversee the procurment and design of Salford's Health and Social Care Centres, including shifting children's services from Pendleton hospital to the new site at Pendleton. Effective stakeholder engagement was a critical feature of this role.
